

Organisation

This international course is organised by Filha (Finland), TBNET (Germany), Karolinska Institute (Sweden) and KNCV TB Plus (the Netherlands) and is held in alternating countries.

Location and data

This year the European Advanced Course on Clinical Tuberculosis (EACCTB) will be organized by Karolinska Institute in collaboration with Hellenic Thoracic Society (HTS) in Athens Greece from 25 – 27 October 2023.

Purpose of the course

The purpose of the course is to improve the capacity of medical specialists in addressing the changing challenges in TB control in the European Region. After the course participants are expected to have improved competence in clinical management of TB as well as in using this knowledge for the advancement of TB control/treatment/management in their countries. The course provides a forum for interaction among specialists as well as for stimulating collaboration.

Target group

Clinicians, nurses and allied professions interested in TB.

Methodology

The training is participatory. The course includes lectures, discussions and group sessions based on exercises and case studies.
